



Arts in Offices Hanging Systems

Each business wishing to participate as a satellite gallery in the Arts in Offices program, must use an approved hanging system. It is the venue's responsibility to install the hanging system. Below are some of the many hanging systems you may choose from:

Basic Picture Molding & Molding Hooks

- Least costly of the hanging systems.
- May be purchased at TW Perry located at 41 Catoctin Circle SE in Leesburg. Their phone number is 703-777-3030. These are not in stock and therefore must be special-ordered; order number is WM-276.
- Preparation: cut to desired length, prime and paint if desired. Screw into wall studs at desired height (at least 7 feet from floor is recommended).
- Molding requires the use of hooks. We recommend that you purchase one hook per linear foot of exhibition wall space. You may purchase these hooks at Ben Franklin, located in shopping center across the street from TW Perry. These hooks are not on display. You must go to the back of the store in the framing department and ask someone at the framing desk to get the hooks out for you.
- Exhibiting artists are responsible for providing their own hanging filament.

Arakawa Hanging System

- Easy to install. Does not need to be primed or painted. More costly than conventional picture molding, but easier to use and gives a more modern appearance. More information is available on their website: www.arakawagrip.com.
